ESTABLISHED JUNE 6th, 1831.

- 1. The School opens at ten minutes after nine in the morning, and twenty minutes before two in the evening. A bell is rung at nine and at half past one, and the names are called over at the end of ten minutes from the first sound of the bell.
- 2. Those children who do not answer to their names are punished by being kept at school after the others are dismissed, allowing a quarter of an hour for every five minutes missed, half an hour for ten minutes, and an hour for twenty minutes.
- 3. No child is at any time allowed to be absent without leave from the Master, obtained by one of his parents or near relations in person the day before. The names of all who are absent both with and without leave are regularly entered


