ELDERS COLLIERS LTD

Garth & Oakwood Collieries, Maesteg Glamorgan

In 1899 Elder's Navigation Collieries Co. (later called Elder's Collieries Ltd) acquired Garth and Oakwood Collieries from previous owners. The Company was owned by shipping magnate Sir Alfred Jones, of Elder Dempster Lines, who set up Elder's Navigation Collieries to produce bunker coal for his steamships.

Sir Alfred Lewis Jones was born on 24 February 1845 in Carmarthen to Daniel Jones and Mary Jean Williams. They moved to Liverpool when Alfred was 3 years old. Aged 12, Alfred was apprenticed to the managers of the African Steamship Company and at the age of 26 was manager of the business. He borrowed money to buy two or three sailing ships and started his own business; he succeeded and made additions to his fleet. Realizing that sailing board were about to be superseded by steamers, he sold his vessels.

He acquired land and business in West Africa and was the first merchant to import bananas to England in 1884 and became friends with the 'Fyffe' family. Ships of the Elder, Dempster & Co. Line became known as the 'banana' boats. He was given the managerial post in the above company in 1891 and also gained shares; he bought further shares until he gained control of the company.

In 1900, in order to supply his ships with bunker fuel and support his coaling stations in the Canary Islands and Sierra Leone, he formed Elder's Navigation Collieries Ltd and bought Oakwood and Garth Merthyr Collieries near Maesteg in the Llynfi valley, south Wales. Sir Alfred Jones had connections with trade in West Africa and cotton in the West Indies. He died on 13 December 1909 in Liverpool.

HM Yacht 'Hersilia'

Serialised form of personal log of Lt. Commander Charles E Evans RNVR., FRGS (Fellow of the Royal Geographic Society) in Western Mails starting Tuesday 1 February 1921 entitled "Doings of the Armed Yacht Hersilia". Commander Evans informed that when he joined Hersilia in December 1914, the yacht had a crew of 26 men including the other watch Lt – Greenwell (25); Evans (56). Navigator – Lt Long RNR; Engineer, Boatswain, petty officers, gun layers, signalmen, etc.

Hersilia was built by Ramage & Ferguson in Leith and launched on 11 March 1895. It was requisitioned by the Admiralty for use as a naval auxiliary patrol vessel and armed with 2 @ 6pdr deck guns. It left Stornoway at 12:15am on 6 January 1916 bound for the Isle of Ornsay. The RNR crew were commanded by Lt. Commander Hugh Henry McLean and Lt. Frank Randell Carte RNR was Navigating Officer. Officer of the Watch was Sub Lt. Henry Fosbrooke when at 4:55am the yacht crashed onto the rocks. The crew safely made it onto shore.
